
## Everyone Please Read This Thoroughly (including your kids & guests)

## Please:


- 1) Participant Paddock Parking is in Areas #5 and #7. These are shown on the attached map.
- 2) NO PARKING IN ANY FIRE LANE (even temporarily). If you do, you WILL be towed. Find a legitimate spot and walk.
- 3) No Parking in Vendor Area unless you are a Vendor.
- 4) No Paddock Setup Parking in Car Show Area #8.
  Car show participants may enter and park in this area but please no canopies, RVs, BBQs, etc. Car show car parking only...
- 5) Management will not get involved in any Participant Parking Space conflict. Try to remain *flexible* and resist "Land Grabbing".
- 6) No Open Car Trailers stored in the paddock. Open Trailers must be parked up on the hill above the paddock in **Dirt Lot 2**.
- 7) Overnight Campers can also use the **Paved Lot 3**.

The Sonoma paddock is small, so please help keep things running smooth. Use Trash and Recycling Cans. Pick up garbage when you see it. The large Participant Paddock Parking Area #5 is where many people will be setting up. Each participant can take a paddock space of up to 20' x 35' Your family/guests/friends should all park in your spot and walk or bike. There is some additional parking at the north end of the grandstands. For those arriving on Thursday, we will not be able to set up in the paddock until after 6pm. Those who arrive at the track with their cars prior to 6pm Thursday can enter but must wait in Dirt Lot 2 or Paved Lot 3 until we can enter the paddock at 6pm.

Please keep in mind that the Drivers Meeting starts at 7:15AM each day and if you miss it you will have difficulty getting your wrist band. Arrive EARLY! Please see the attached Paddock Area #5 drawing for detailed paddock setup info.



## SAAC-46 "B" Paddock / Area 5 Participant Paddock Parking



The paddock space at Sonoma is limited and there are a large number of participants who need paddock space, so we need to pack people in tightly. A Paddock Team Member will be guiding each participant to their spot Friday morning. We will be filling spaces closest to Vendor Parking first and work our way up to the top. Once B Paddock is full, we will be directing people to the North end of C Paddock / Area 7.

Each registered participant with one open track or vintage race car and a tow rig can have a paddock space of up to  $35' \times 20'$  (two  $35' \times 10'$ ).

Participants who drive their car to the track (no tow rig) will get one 35' x 10' section. See the examples above. Don't worry this should be plenty. If not, let us know when you arrive.

Enclosed car haulers may be parked in the paddock, but open trailers may not. If you have an enclosed trailer you want to park in the paddock, please let us know when you arrive so we can accommodate you. Open trailers **must** be parked / stored in Dirt Lot 2.

We will try to ensure that the rows will have chalk hash marks every 10'.
